Flight Lands: A coach will pick you up from Brisbane International Airport in the morning.

Rather than teach the four disciplines as separate and discrete subjects, STEM integrates them into a cohesive learning paradigm based on real world applications.

What separates STEM from the traditional science and math education is the blended learning environment and showing students how the scientific method can be applied to everyday life. It teaches students computational thinking and focuses on the real world applications of problem solving.

These amazing, hands-on classes include drone flying, 3D printing creating, designing your own cartoon character to take home, and more.

This special workshop is also a certificate course, so you'll have the qualifications to show off your new skills when you return home.

Not only will you see and meet these animals, but your trip to the koala sanctuary is an excellent learning opportunity. The facilities are designed to educate you on native Australian flora and fauna as you patrol the property in beautiful, natural settings.
